HARVESTS HAVE BEGUN!

Our official harvests began Friday June 1st and, so far, members have seen a variety of produce in their harvest boxes including spinach, arugula, lettuce, bok choy, radishes, peas, garlic scapes, strawberries, and a limited amount of asparagus. An asparagus crown will typically produce 6 to 8 spears in a season, but they emerge from the soil one spear at a time so we need quite a few plants to satisfy the demand. Our goal is to expand the asparagus bed so that all of our members can enjoy them. We planted several varieties of Asian greens this year, including yukina, a dark leafy green similar to spinach, and Tokyo

bekana, a beautiful chartreuse colored leaf that is a wonderful addition to salads. The planting beds are almost full and we look forward to many bountiful harvests going forward.
